ABSENTEE VOTING



Absentee voting is a type of voting that allows for absent members to vote. This can be done through voting by proxy (giving another person the authority to cast votes for you) and voting by mail. Both Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised and the American Institute of Parliamentarians Standard Code of Parliamentary Procedure require authorization in the bylaws for absentee voting.
