ELECTRONIC MEETINGS

Electronic meetings were added in Robert's Rules Newly Revised, 11th Edition (pp. 97-99). In order to qualify under the requirements of a deliberative assembly, there must be simultaneous aural communication. Electronic meetings must also be authorized in the organization's bylaws. Thus, e-mails and social media do not qualify as valid transactions in a regular or properly called meeting.
