Ex Officio

Ex officio means "by virtue of another office." For example, the president may be an member of X Committee simply because he holds the office of president. Ex officio members may vote (since they are members of the organization and have such rights) -- unless the bylaws strictly say otherwise. In RONR, they do not have the obligations as other members and are not counted in the quorum.
