GORDIAN KNOT

The Gordian Knot is a motion specific to AIP Standard Code of Parliamentary Procedure as a variation of the motion to suspend the rules. It allows the assembly to "reset" to a less confusing checkpoint, usually the last undisposed main motion stated by the chair. It requires a 2/3s vote.
